
Justice

- > Prayers "O God, guide me..." & sing "O God! Educate these children..."
- > **Drama** / Song Ruhi Book 3a: p30 warm up exercises – imaginary circle, p46 Harvest time
- > Quote read, explain and memorise it.
 "Tread ye | the path of justice, | for this, verily | is the straight path."
 make memorisation picture cards, or learn it in 4 groups (each group just learns their bit), then take turns to say out loud the whole quote.
- > **Craft** Make a mobile (keep the balance stay on the straight path) use 2 skewers, tie them together in a 'cross', attach string to ends, and one in middle for hanging the mobile; attach circles with virtues written on them at the end of the 4 strings.
- > **Story**book 3a p45, or book 3 p20-21 find pictures for story, illustrate it
- > Colour in lesson picture
- > Game Fruit Salad

Each child is given a fruit name – apple, strawberry, banana, cherry, pear, pineapple, etc. The teacher calls out one fruit after another each time 'your fruit' is called, you have to switch seat, when the teacher calls fruitsalad, all have to swap seats...
